

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO SELL OR DELIVER GASOLINE, KEROSENE, FUEL OIL OR OTHER COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS IN JUGS, BOTTLES, JARS, OR OTHER GLASS CONTAINERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to sell or deliver gasoline, kerosene, fuel oil, naphtha, benzine or other combustible liquids to any person within the city limits of the City of Springfield in Bay County, Florida, in a jug, bottle, jar or other glass container.

SECTION 2: Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$50.00 or by imprisonment in the city jail for a period not exceeding 10 days, or by both fine and imprisonment in the city jail.




