ORDINANCE NO. 100

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD DEFINING AND DECLARING THE OFFENSE OF PETTY LARCENY TO BE UNLAWFUL AND PROVIDING A PENALTY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Whoever in the City of Springfield in Bay County, Florida, commits petty larceny by stealing of the property of another any money, goods, or chattels, if the property stolen is of the value of less than ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) shall be deemed guilty of petty larceny, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by imprisonment in the city jail not to exceed sixty (60) days or by fine not to exceed TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. Petty larceny for the purpose of this ordinance shall be defined as any act which would constitute petty larceny under the State law.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
