

ORDINANCE NO. 130

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1: As provided by the City Charter, the regular Police Department of the City shall consist of a chief of police and such other officers as may be appointed from time to time by the City Commission; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, whenever he deems it necessary, <sup>by reason of emergency</sup> the Mayor shall have the power and authority to appoint temporary police officers and when so appointed they shall be vested with the same police power as regular police officers and each shall be entitled to be paid by the City at the rate of \$ 14.00 per eight-hour day actually worked. Any such temporary appointee may be removed or discharged by majority action of the City Commission during any meeting lawfully assembled.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
