

ORDINANCE NO: 137

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE # 921  
RELATING TO A LEVY OF A TAX ON INSURANCE  
PREMIUM AND SETTING UP FIREMEN'S RELIEF  
AND PENSION FUND FOR CITY OF SPRINGFIELD;  
PROVIDING FOR REFUND TO STATE OF TAX PROCEEDS;  
PROVIDING DISPOSITION OF ACCUMULATED INTEREST.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD IN  
BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: Ordinance # 921 is hereby  
repealed.

SECTION 2: All monies received from the State  
as proceeds of the tax levied under said ordinance shall be  
returned to the State Agency from whence it came.

SECTION 3: All accumulation of interest, if any,  
on said tax funds shall be paid over into the Volunteer  
Firemen's Fund of the City of Springfield to be used for civic  
purposes.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect  
immediately.
