AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE HOURS AND TIMES OF SALE OF ALCOHOLIC AND INTOXICATING BEVERAGES IN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD AND FIXING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 129

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: The lawful hours of sale of

alcoholic and intoxicating beverages in the City of Springfield shall be the same as the hours of lawful sale established for unincorporated areas of Bay County, Florida, either by statute or by the County Commissioners, and it shall be unlawful to sell, offer for sale, serve, consume, ~~and~~ allow to be served, sold or consumed any alcoholic or intoxicating beverages upon any premises holding a beverage license from the State and City, at any time except during lawful hours of sale.

SECTION 2: Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not exceeding \$500.00 or by imprisonment of not more than sixty (60) days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.

SECTION 4: Ordinance No. _____ is hereby repealed.
