

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING OFFICERS OF FIRE DEPARTMENT AUTHORITY TO DIRECT TRAFFIC AT SCENE OF FIRE; PROVIDING A PENALTY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1: Officers of the Fire Department, when at the scene of a fire, are hereby authorized to direct or assist the Police in directing traffic thereat or in the immediate vicinity.

Section 2: No person shall willfully fail or refuse to comply with any lawful order or direction of a Fire Department Official.

Section 3: Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by fine, not to exceed \$100.00, or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than 10 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by Law.
