


AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PROCESSION OR PARADE PERMITS AND PROVIDING A PENALTY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA:


Section 1: No person shall participate in any procession or parade containing ten (10) or more persons or ten (10) or more vehicles, excepting the armed forces of the United States, the military forces of the State of Florida, the forces of the police and fire departments of the city, and funeral processions, which occupies or proceeds along any street in the city except in accordance with a permit therefore issued by the chief of police and in accordance with such other regulations as are herein set forth which may apply.

Section 2: Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by fine, not to exceed \$ 500.00 or by imprisonment in the city jail for not more than 90 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
