

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION I, ORDINANCE
NO. 19, AND PROVIDING A MINIMUM BUILDING
PERMIT OF \$5.00.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD IN BAY
COUNTY, FLORIDA:


Section 1: Section I of Ordinance No. 19 of the City of
Springfield in Bay County, Florida is hereby amended to read as
follows:


Section I: That from and after the date this
ordinance takes effect it shall be unlawful for any
person, firm or corporation to erect, build, construct,
renovate or move any edifice or building of whatsoever
nature within the limits of the City of Springfield in
Bay County, Florida, unless and until such person, firm
or corporation shall have secured from the Building
Inspector a permit to so build, erect, construct, reno-
vate or move any edifice or building within the limits
of the City of Springfield in Bay County, Florida. The
cost of said permit shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) where
anticipated costs do not exceed One Thousand Dollars
(\$1,000.00) and One Dollar and 50/100 (\$1.50) per \$1,000.00
or fraction thereof in excess of \$1,000.00.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided
by law.
