

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION I, ORDINANCE 31, PROVIDING AN INCREASE IN CONNECTING FEE FOR ALL CONNECTIONS ONTO THE CITY WATER MAINS OR LINES AFTER THE WATER SYSTEM OF THE CITY IS IN OPERATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 31 of the City of Springfield in Bay County, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1: A connection fee shall be charged by the city for each connection to the City water mains or lines after the City Water System is placed in operation in order to help defray the cost of connection. Said fee shall be a sum equal to the City's acquisition cost of a new meter of size and description of the meter to be used in said connection. The fee shall be rounded off at the next highest amount in multiples of Five Dollars (\$5.00).

Section 2: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
