No person shall in anyway discharge any type of effluent material into the public sewer system except in accordance with the regulations of the Department of Environmental Regulation of the State of Florida or the Federal Environmental Protection Agency and County Ordinances, and must possess written permission from the City of Springfield.
- SECTION 2. No storage of discharged or effluent material shall be allowed within the corporate limits of the City of Springfield, without written permission from the City of Springfield.
