AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING THE FOLLOWING UNINCORPORATED AREA OF BAY COUNTY WHICH IS CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA, UPON PETITION OF THE OWNER OF SAID PROPERTY: 5310 EAST 14<sup>TH</sup> STREET, PARCEL ID 14974-000-000, AS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN THE BODY OF THE ORDINANCE; REDEFINING THE BOUNDARY LINES OF THE CITY; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY UPON PASSAGE.

Section 2. The boundary lines of the City of Springfield, Florida, are redefined to include therein said tracts of land.


