

A R E S O L U T I O N

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE COMMON BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN
THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY AND THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, IN
BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, the common boundary line between the City of Panama City and the City of Springfield is presently along a quarter section line, and

WHEREAS, this quarter section line runs generally along Everitt Avenue. However, near the southerly end of said Everitt Avenue said section line is slightly eastward of Everitt Avenue, thus resulting in some home and property owners on the east side of Everitt Avenue having the front portions of their property in Panama City and the back portions of their property in Springfield, and

WHEREAS, much confusion therefore exists as to property taxation of these properties affected, and the jurisdiction of the two cities' and their police forces, and therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA:

That the Legislature of the State of Florida is hereby requested, at its 1955 session, to pass a special act making Everitt Avenue, as it exists and as it is extended, the common boundary line between the City of Panama City and the City of Springfield, in Bay County, Florida.
