

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, water rates have been set by Ordinance No. 34 at Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2.50) minimum per month for residential users, and

WHEREAS, garbage rates have been set by Ordinance No. X at One Dollar (\$1.00) per month for residential users, and

WHEREAS, it is the desires of the City Commission of the City of Springfield to make water available at the lowest rates possible, and to provide garbage service as extensively as possible for the protection of the health of the citizens and residents of the City, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the City should offer its citizens a minimum rate of Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2.50) for water (with garbage collection included for a one-family dwelling at no extra cost), and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA:

That the minimum monthly rate of Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2.50) heretofore established by ordinance for water for residences shall include garbage collection for a one-family dwelling at no extra cost.

That where multiple dwelling units are on the same meter, only garbage collection for one family unit shall be included in the Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2.50) minimum for water, and all other dwelling units shall be required to pay the usual (One Dollar) \$1.00 per month garbage collection rate.

That the garbage collection rate shall remain at One Dollar (\$1.00) per month for all residential users not connected to the city water distribution system, and all business users of the service shall be required to pay the same rate as heretofore, except that if they use city water, they shall be entitled to a reduction of One Dollar (\$1.00) per month in the previously

existing or future garbage fees established for non-users of water.

That a deposit of Six Dollars (\$6.00) (Five Dollars for water and One Dollar for garbage) shall be required of each applicant for water service at residences, which will be refundable.

That places of business shall be required to make a water deposit of Five Dollars (\$5.00) and a deposit on garbage collection equal to the monthly rate which they are required to pay for garbage collection for the particular service they require, which deposit shall be refundable.

That a connection fee will be charged on the water bill of One Dollar for each connection or re-connection of water service.

There shall be no charge for a tapping fee or connection fee to the water system prior to the commencement of operation of the system, but after the system is placed in operation, there shall be a flat charge of Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) for tapping fee or connection fee for each meter of the new water system, in addition to the other charges hereinabove mentioned, which shall not be refundable.
