

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of this City Commission that the BAY LINE RAILROAD is making an application for discontinuance of its passenger train from Panama City to Dothan, Alabama, and

WHEREAS, although Panama City is at the end of the line, this train serves over 50,000 residents of Bay County, and is a necessary and vital link in the transportation system of this area,
NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Springfield, in Bay County, Florida:

That the BAY LINE RAILROAD be requested to continue to operate its passenger train from Panama City, Florida, to Dothan, Alabama, in the interest of necessity, progress, and continued growth of the whole of Bay County.

That a copy of this resolution be sent to Mr. H. H. Sims, President of the BAY LINE RAILROAD, and the Florida Railroad and Public Utilities Commission.
