

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, it has been brought to my attention that some individuals and groups in the City of Springfield have brought complaints about the way the City Commission has issued alcoholic beverage license in the past by not complying with Ordinance # 17.

WHEREAS, as Mayor of the City of Springfield, I would like to submit the following resolution for adoption this 1st day of December, 1960.

WHEREAS the above mention complaints have been registered with me, and

WHEREAS, it was not the intention of the City Commission to violate any stipulation of Ordinance # 17, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Commission to serve all the people of Springfield impartially, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA:

That in the future there be no alcoholic beverage license issued that will any way conflict with Ordinance # 17, regardless of petitions issued by any person or number of persons and that the City Commission in the future adhere strictly to the stipulation contained within Ordinance # 17, controlling the issuance of alcoholic beverage license within the city limits, of the City of Springfield.
