

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, Ira L. Hill and wife, Elma Hill, have by written proposal received by and filed with the City Clerk of the City of Springfield, Florida offered to donate to the City of Springfield, Florida for the use and benefit of the Public, the property now owned by them and described as follows:

Beginning at the SW Corner of Lot 7, Block 1, Springfield Plat as per Plat Book 2, Page 3; thence run North along the West Boundary Line of said Lot 7 a distance of 150 feet to the Northwest corner of said Lot 7; thence run East along the Northern Boundary Line of said Lot 7 a distance of 30 feet; thence run South a distance of 150 feet to the South Boundary Line of said Lot 7; thence run West a distance of 30 feet to the point of beginning. Said described premises comprise an area 30 feet wide and 150 feet long off of the West Side of Lot 7, Block 1, Springfield Plat per Plat Book 2, Page 3,

for the purpose of a public street, and

WHEREAS, it is to the interest and benefit of the City of Springfield, Florida and the public at large that the gift proposal be accepted by the City of Springfield, Florida; therefore be it Resolved:
