

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, in the past the city has had no set policy in regard to Christmas bonuses for employees of the city, and WHEREAS, this commission feels that it is advisable and to the best interest of the city to set such a policy, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA:

that the employees of said city who are under civil service receive on each and every Christmas a bonus in a sum equal to one-half (1/2) of a day's pay for each year of service. All employees with less than one year's service shall nevertheless receive a Christmas bonus equal to one-half (1/2) of a day's pay. In computing years of service any fractional part of the first year's service shall be considered as one year.

THIS RESOLUTION passed this 8 day of July, A. D. 1966, in regular session of the City Commission of the City of Springfield.
