

R E S O L U T I O N


WHEREAS, the Charter of the CITY OF SPRINGFIELD IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, has been amended so as to reduce the total number of Commissioners from six (6) to five (5) thereby reducing the total authorized expenditures of said Commissioners for expenses incurred in connection with handling the affairs of the City, and

WHEREAS, the responsibility which has formerly been shared by six (6) Commissioners is now shared by five (5) of the Commissioners, and

WHEREAS, inflation continues to devalue the dollar,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Commission of the City of Springfield in Bay County, Florida unanimously approve of and recommend to the Legislature of the State of Florida the amendments contained in the proposed legislation attached hereto, and identified by the initials of the Mayor on each page.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ACT AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF
SPRINGFIELD, IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, SAME
BEING CHAPTER 27900 LAWS OF FLORIDA, ACTS
OF 1951, RELATING TO COMPENSATION OF OFFICERS.

BE IN ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: Sub-section (1) of Section 11 of Chapter 27900,
Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1951, is hereby amended to read
as follows:

Section 11. Compensation of officers and employees.--

(1) The commission shall fix, by ordinance, the salary
or compensation of the city attorney, municipal judge, the
heads of the departments, members of the police and fire
forces, and members of boards, the number and compensations
of all other officers and employees. The mayor commissioner
and each commissioner serving as a member of the city commission
shall be entitled to receive such compensation, not to exceed
\$60.00 per month each, as may be prescribed from time to
time by resolution of the city commission. All such salaries
and rates of pay with dates of employment and discharge shall
be immediately reported to the city auditor and clerk. All
fees and moneys received or collected by officers and
employees shall be immediately paid over to the city
treasurer and collector on the date of their receipt. The
city, as part of the compensation of officers and employees,
may pay for accident and hospitalization insurance.

SECTION 2: This Act shall take effect immediately.
