

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the water system of THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, is presently inadequate to meet the needs of the people of said City in that in many areas of said City presently being served the pressure is completely inadequate, and there are other areas in that City and adjacent thereto which could be served if adequate pressure was available, and

WHEREAS, said City has on deposit the sum of \$17,729.45 in the Bay National Bank and Trust Co., Panama City, Florida, in a fund designated "City of Springfield Water Department, Renewal and Replacement Fund", the same subject to Ordinance No. 68 dated August 1, 1955, authorizing the issue of bonds for financing the water system of said City, and

WHEREAS, J. B. CONVERSE & CO., INC., Engineers for the City of Springfield have recommended certain improvements and extensions of the present system.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That funds necessary to finance the improvements and extensions recommended by J. B. CONVERSE & CO., INC. be transferred from the Renewal and Replacement fund to a "Construction Fund", the same to be ear-marked for use in improving and extending the present water system of the City of Springfield in Bay County, Florida in accordance with the plans and specifications provided by its Engineers.

Passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Springfield, Florida, this 5th day of August, 1968.
