

R E S O L U T I O N

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO IMPROVING STATE ROAD NO. 22, BY WIDENING SAID HIGHWAY TO CARRY FOUR LANES OF TRAFFIC, WHICH IS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Bay County, Florida have, for the past several years, sought assistance from the State of Florida in initiating an improvement program for State Road No. 22, and it appearing that said road is now, and has for a long period of time been in a deplorable condition, and it further appearing that said road is an arterial highway for the citizens and residents of Callway, Springfield, Parker and other surrounding communities, and it appearing that said road is heavily traveled by many of the sportsmen of Bay County, Florida, as well as the business and professional people of this area, and it appearing that the need for this improvement should be considered as a priority for road construction in Bay County, and NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by this Commission go on record as unanimously supporting and requesting the proper authorities to improve state road No. 22 from its intersection with U.S. 98-Business, in the City of Springfield, in Bay County, Florida, east to the eastern limits of said city by widening said highway to carry four lanes of traffic and by adding curbs and gutters.

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER that this resolution be spread upon the minutes of this Commission and that copies be sent to the appropriate officials.
