

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, WILL CONSIDER PASSAGE OF AN ORDINANCE VACATING, ABANDONING AND CLOSING A CERTAIN STREET OR ALLEY IN SAID CITY AT ITS NEXT REGULAR MEETING, TO BE HELD ON THE FIRST DAY OF JUNE, 1970.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD:

That at its next regular meeting, which will be held at 6:30 p.m. on the first day of June, 1970, the City Commission of the City of Springfield will consider passage of an ordinance vacating, abandoning and closing that portion of Bayou Avenue between Fifth Street and Fifth Court, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is 1,063 feet south of the NE corner of the NE quarter of the NE quarter of Section 11, T 4 S, R 14 W; running thence south 250 feet; thence west, 270 feet for the Point of Beginning; thence north 326 feet; thence west 30 feet; thence south 326 feet; thence east 30 feet to the Point of Beginning.

That a copy of this Resolution be published in some newspaper in Bay County, Florida being qualified to publish legal advertisements one time at least two weeks prior to the aforementioned meeting at which said ordinance is to be considered.
