

RESOLUTION

The City Council of the City of Springfield, Florida
at its regular meeting on the 1st day of June, 1970,
(or at a special session as the case may be) unanimously passed
and adopted the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is aware of the applica-
tion now pending before the Florida Public Service Commission of
Norvie E. Paulk, and

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield wishes to express its
support of the granting of the aforesaid application, and

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is desirous of expressing
its support of the aforesaid application to the Florida Public
Service Commission, Tallahassee, Florida, 32304, and

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield has good cause to
believe and does believe that transportation services requested
by the Applicant if authorized and granted would greatly benefit
the Citizens and especially the shipping public which constitutes
and comprises the Citizenship of Springfield, Florida, and

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield does not have an MH
Certificate holder domiciled within its City limits and applicant
is located within the Corporate Limits of the City and has adequate
warehouse and office space as well as motor vehicle equipment, and

WHEREAS, the population of the City of Springfield has
been rapidly increasing over the past several years, the transporta-
tion services have not increased at a proportionate rate, and there-
fore be it

RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Springfield
that this Resolution be and the same is hereby adopted and copies
of same be mailed to Honorable Howard E. Cartaway, Administrative

Secretary, Florida Public Service Commission, for the purpose of showing the support of the City of Springfield for the granting of the application of Norvie E. Paulk.
