

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO CHRISTMAS BONUSES  
FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD

WHEREAS, the past policy of the City with reference to Christmas bonuses for employees has been vague and indefinite in some respects, and

WHEREAS this Commission feels that it is advisable and to the best interest of the City to adopt a new policy correcting certain deficiencies in the old policy,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Springfield, Bay County, Florida, that all employees of the City receive on each and every Christmas a bonus which shall be considered as a part of the salary of said employees, and that the amount of said bonus be based upon a sliding scale relative to years of service.

Beginning with Christmas of 1970 and to continue until further action of this Commission, all of the employees of said City shall receive Christmas bonuses in accordance with the following schedule:

Employment for any period up to one year	\$ 25.00
Over one year up to two years	35.00
Over two years up to three years	45.00
Over three years up to four years	55.00
Over four years up to five years	65.00
Over five years up to six years	75.00
Over six years up to seven years	85.00
Over seven years up to eight years	95.00
Over eight years up to nine years	100.00

No bonus shall exceed the total sum of \$100.00, regardless of time of service.
