

R E S O L U T I O N

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE CROSSING OF
FLORIDA STATE HIGHWAY 22-A (SCHOOL AVENUE-
5TH STREET) IN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD IN
BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, BY THE BAY LINE
RAILROAD.

WHEREAS, an elementary school, a junior high school
and a high school are located on Florida State Highway 22-A
(School Avenue) in close proximity to the Bay Line crossing of
said street with its intersection with 5th Street, and

WHEREAS, the location of these three schools on said
highway causes unique problems with pedestrian and motor traffic,
and

WHEREAS, it appears that there may well be a real
problem with the safe negotiation of motorists and pedestrians
traveling through the above mentioned crossing, and

WHEREAS, at present there are no railroad control
lights in this location, and

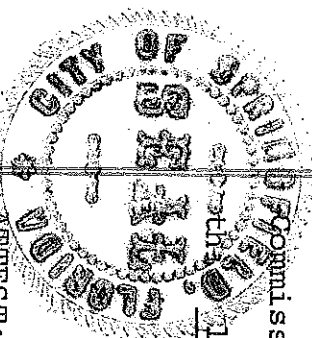
WHEREAS, this Commission feels that there is a strong
likelihood of a crucial need for railroad lights for said loca-
tion,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission
of the City of Springfield, Bay County, Florida, that the State
of Florida, through its appropriate agencies, conduct a survey
to determine the need for railroad lights for said location.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution
be delivered to the appropriate state division or bureau and
that a copy be delivered to the Bay County Board of Commissioners.
