

RESOLUTION

The City Council of the City of Springfield in Bay County, Florida, at its regular meeting on the 5th day of April, 1971, unanimously passed and adopted the following Resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED that this body by these presents do strongly urge the Board of County Commissioners of Bay County, Florida to take all necessary and desirable steps for the establishment of sewer, water, or drainage districts to meet the needs of the residents of Bay County in the area of the County lying east of Panama City, Florida, the same incorporating the municipalities of Town of Cedar Grove, City of Springfield in Bay County, Florida, City of Parker, and City of Callaway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Bay County, Florida, in cooperation with the governing bodies of the above named municipalities, make every effort to utilize available state and federal funds to aid in financing the projects of the district or districts which have been established.
