The City Commission of the City of Springfield, Bay County, Florida, meeting in Regular Session on the 5th day of June, 1972, adopted the following resolution which is now in full force and effect:

WHEREAS, the City of Panama City has been offered the opportunity to participate jointly with the Florida Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration in a traffic operations program to improve capacity and safety on a major part of the highway and street systems serving the greater Panama City Urban Areas, and,

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield has been invited to be a cosigner of a Memorandum of Agreement to be established between the Florida Department of Transportation and Panama City, that will initiate the proposed program identified as TOPICS, and,

WHEREAS, the first phase of TOPICS will be a study to determine the overall traffic operation needs for the area financed by the Florida Department of Transportation, and, the Federal Highway Administration, and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Springfield that the City participate in the first phase of the TOPICS program, at no cost to the City,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the City of Springfield participate in the first phase of the TOPICS Program and make available data useful for study purposes.
