A Resolution pertaining to the desire of the City of Springfield not to purchase back time for City Employees under the Florida Retirement System.

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Commission of the City of Springfield is interested in providing it's employees with liberal benefits and


WHEREAS, The City of Springfield provides for it's employees a Pension Fund under the Florida Retirement System and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Commission of the City of Springfield feel an obligation and duty to the Citizens of the City of Springfield to operate the City on sound business and financial principles and


WHEREAS, The Mayor and Commission of the City of Springfield is pledged to making expenditures within a planned budget governed by sound business principles and judgement in keeping with income

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Mayor and Commission of the City of Springfield is determining by this resolution that it would not be in keeping with their pledge to operate the City of Springfield for it's citizens within a designated budget and anticipated projected income to purchase back time for it's employees under the Florida Retirement System.
