

WHEREAS, the drainage and street paving deficiencies of the Robindale Revitalization Area constitute a major public work deficiency in the City of Springfield, Florida which is a blighting condition for this entire area; and


WHEREAS, the Robindale Revitalization Area is a residential neighborhood inhabited primarily by low-to-moderate income families; and  
WHEREAS, the City of Springfield, Florida desires to obtain Community Development Block Grant funds to provide proper drainage and street paving facilities for the Robindale Revitalization Area; and

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that:

1. The City of Springfield, Florida hereby authorizes the submission of a Community Development Block Grant application to the Department of Community Affairs, State of Florida, to secure a grant in the amount of \$649,000, the proceeds of which are to be used to construct storm drainage and street paving facilities to serve the Robindale Revitalization Area.
2. The Mayor of the City of Springfield, as Chief Elected Official, is hereby authorized to sign all documents required to complete said grant application.
