Whereas, it has been determined that the introduction of fluoride into water supplies intended for human consumption is necessary for the protection of the dental health and welfare of citizens; and

Whereas, the Florida Department of Environmental Regulation permits the addition of fluoride to public water supplies as authorized by Chapter 17-22 of the Florida Administrative Code; and

Whereas, local dental and medical professionals encourage the application of fluoride to the Bay County public water supply for protection of the dental health and welfare of its citizens; and

Whereas, the Bay County Health Department and Bay County School Board encourage and support the addition of fluoride to the Bay County water supply for protection of the dental health and welfare of its citizens; and

Whereas, the local American Cancer Society and American Heart Association support the addition of fluoride to the Bay County water supply,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of SPRINGFIELD, Florida in lawful session assembled that the Bay County Board of Commissioners causes to be installed, equipment for the purpose of applying fluoride to the public water supply of the Bay County Water and Wastewater Systems in accordance with regulations set forth in Chapter 17-22 of the Florida Administrative Code.
