

RESOLUTION NO. 94-05

A RESOLUTION IN OPPOSITION TO CASINO TYPE GAMBLING IN THE STATE OF FLORIDA; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, certain types of gambling and gambling establishments commonly known as casino gambling are illegal in the State of Florida, and

WHEREAS, there is an effort under way to amend the Florida Constitution to allow casino gambling and to use certain proceeds to fund governmental programs, and

WHEREAS, the introduction of casino gambling in Florida will have a negative impact on family oriented tourism which is the backbone of the state's tourism industry, and

WHEREAS, the cost to government and communities will far exceed the revenue returned to government and communities by gambling activities, and

WHEREAS, neither the public or government will benefit from casino gambling;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the City Commission of the City of Springfield, Florida, opposes any change in the State Constitution or State Law which would allow casino gambling in Florida.


Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
