**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD,
FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF OVERTIME
FOR DESIGNATED PERSONS DURING EMERGENCIES.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 8.8 of the Municipal Charter of the City of Springfield, the Mayor is vested with the duty and responsibility to govern by proclamation during times of grave public danger or emergency; and

WHEREAS, certain persons are employed by the City on a salary basis and are not eligible to earn overtime, even during times of emergency; and


WHEREAS, the City Commission recognizes the significant sacrifice of time and resources of these employees;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Springfield, Florida, that

When the Bay County Emergency Operations Center is officially activated, the Mayor, then will designate those individuals who are salaried that will be directly involved with declared emergency operations of the City. The designated employees will be required to initiate a time card, and keep their time in the same manner as required for hourly employees, to enable the City to reimburse said employees for overtime hours worked during the declared emergency.

This resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
