RESOLUTION No: 96-01

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THAT THE CONSIDERATION RECEIVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS FOR THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, AS A RESULT OF THEIR OFFICIAL POSITIONS, SHALL BE CATEGORIZED AS A "FEE" AND THIS CATEGORIZATION SHALL APPLY TO ALL CONSIDERATIONS THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS WILL RECEIVE AS OF JANUARY 1, 1996

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Commissioners for the City of Springfield are elected to serve the citizens of the community; and

WHEREAS, in the performance of their official positions, the Mayor and City Commissioners are required to attend monthly and special meetings, along with other obligations that may arise, and


WHEREAS, Ordinance 297 of the City of Springfield provides that the Mayor and City Commissioners shall be compensated for holding these positions; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 297 has been in existence and effective for at least five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, the current Mayor and City Commissioners, along with their predecessors, have received the aforementioned payments on a monthly basis;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, by the Commissioners of the city of Springfield, Florida, that the consideration received by the Mayor and Commissioners as a result of their official positions shall be categorized as a "fee" and this categorization applies retroactively to all newly elected officials as of September 1994 to all considerations paid for the Mayor and Commissioners.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Mayor and Commissioners for the City of Springfield, Florida did on the 2nd day of January, 1996, adopt this aforementioned Resolution.
