RESOLUTION NO. : 96-04

AN RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD,
FLORIDA; AMENDING THE RETIREMENT PLAN AND
TRUST FOR THE FIREFIGHTERS AND POLICE
OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA;
PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in order to establish an alternative retirement plan and opt-out of the Florida Retirement System, the City Commission of the City of Springfield, joined the Florida Municipal Pension Trust Fund and established a Retirement Plan and Trust for the Firefighters and Police Officers of the City of Springfield, Florida, pursuant to Ordinance Resolution No. : 95-8; and

WHEREAS, technical corrections that have no fiscal impact need to be made to the Plan Document; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to ratify and confirm the provisions of the Retirement Plan and Trust; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA; that

Section 1. The City Commission of the City of Springfield, Florida, hereby approves the changes as set out forth in the restated Plan Document, attached hereto as Exhibit "B",


Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Springfield, Florida, hereby ratifies and confirms the provisions of the Plan as attached hereto in the form of the Adoption Agreement, Plan Document and Florida Municipal Pension Trust Fund Master Trust Agreement, attached hereto as exhibits herein.

Section 3. The City Commission of the City of Springfield, Florida, empowers the Mayor with the authority to execute such documents and agreements as are required to effectuate these amendments of the Plan.

Section 4. All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof, in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Resolution shall be effective January 1, 1996.
