A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT TO THE BAY COUNTY
CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AND OTHER GOVERNMENT
ENTITIES WITHIN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA TOWARDS
THE DEVELOPMENT OF A COUNTY-WIDE UNIFORM
LAND USE CODES AND RESPECTIVE DEFINITIONS

WHEREAS, request has been made upon the City Commission of the City of
Springfield, Florida by the Local Government Committee of the Bay County Chamber of
Commerce to resolve to cooperate with other government entities within Bay County
Florida towards mutually beneficial goals and

WHEREAS, the City Commission as been advised that the Bay County Chamber of
Commerce acting through it's Local Government Committee has identified the need to
bring Land Use Codes and their respective definitions into uniformity throughout all
government entities within Bay County, Florida as one of these mutually beneficial goals and

WHEREAS, the City Commission, although not approving any changes to current
codes or definitions at this time, does hereby recognize the impact on economic growth that
the lack of uniform Land Use Codes and their respective definitions creates and


WHEREAS, the City Commission is interested in cooperating with other government
entities within Bay County, Florida in making changes that will improve our community
and not interrupt any future plans or needs of the City or otherwise be an derogation of
public rights or interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Springfield, Florida, does hereby conceptually support modifications to provisions contained in the Land Development Regulations Code towards the development of county-wide uniform Land Use Codes together with respective definitions.


