

RESOLUTION 97-10  
AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD  
STATE/CDBG BLOCK GRANT  
HURRICANE OPAL MITIGATION RECOVERY APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Community Affairs/Division of Housing and Community Development (DCA) has conditional approved the allocation of State of Florida-Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Hurricane Opal Mitigation Recovery funds to assist local communities in replacing damaged public infrastructure as required to address Hurricane Opal related impacts.

WHEREAS, it is advantageous for the City to take action to correct known public infrastructure deficiencies intensified by the impact of Hurricane Opal; and


WHEREAS, the City wishes to secure CDBG financial assistance for this purpose for the benefit of residents in the local area.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of City Commissioners of Springfield, Florida, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, do hereby resolve that on this the 5<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1997, the below listed actions are authorized:

1. The submission of a grant application to the Florida Department of Community Affairs/Division of Housing and Community Development to secure Hurricane Opal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Mitigation Recovery funding for replacing the 7<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge, in the City of Springfield.
2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute this Resolution, and other documents as required by DCA to submit the CDBG application and implement the grant, subsequent to award by the Florida Department of Community Affairs (DCA).
3. The Mayor and the City Clerk are authorized to execute all CDBG grant related documents that do not require execution by the Board of Commissioners as determined by DCA.
