RESOLUTION NO.: 97- 11

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AND APPROVING THE ATTACHED FLORIDA STATEWIDE MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT AND THE ATTACHED MODIFICATION #1 TO THE AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the State Emergency Management Act, Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, authorizes the state and its political subdivisions to develop and enter into mutual aid agreements for reciprocal emergency aid and assistance in case of emergencies too extensive to be dealt with unassisted; and

WHEREAS, on June 2, 1997, the Commissioners of the City of Springfield approved an agreement with the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management concerning the Statewide Mutual Aid Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Community Affairs requires municipalities to participate in the Statewide Mutual Aid Agreement to be eligible for funds under Administrative Rule 9G-19, Base Funding for County Emergency Management Agencies and Municipal Competitive Grant and Loan Programs;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, THAT

Section 1. That execution of the attached Statewide Mutual Aid Agreement and the attached Modification to the Agreement is hereby authorized, and the Agreement and Modification #1 are hereby approved;

Section 2. That this Resolution will go into effect immediately upon its passage and

adoption and authentication by the signature of the Mayor of the City of Springfield, Florida.
