

**CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA**

**RESOLUTION 97-16**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA, AS A JOINT OWNER, PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION TO BAY COUNTY, AS THE SYSTEM OPERATOR, TO TENTATIVELY AWARD A CONTRACT FOR THE MILITARY POINT REGIONAL ADVANCED WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY, TO DANIS HEAVY CONSTRUCTION, PURSUANT TO THE FLORIDA STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN PROGRAM, SUBJECT TO REGULATORY APPROVAL, PROVIDING FOR SUBSEQUENT EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS BY THE MAYOR; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION TO BAY COUNTY TO NEGOTIATE ON COSTS FOR ADDITIVE ALTERNATIVE BIDS; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION OF A FIVE PERCENT (5%) CONTINGENCY ALLOWANCE, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, City of Springfield, as a joint owner, wishes to utilize funds from the Florida State Revolving Fund Loan Program to construct the Military Point Regional Advanced Wastewater Treatment Facility; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 24, 1997, bids were received for the construction of the Military Point Regional Advanced Wastewater Treatment Facility; and

**WHEREAS**, Baskerville-Donovan, Inc., the System Engineer for the project has recommended tentative award of the base bid contract to Danis Heavy Construction, in the amount of Twenty-One Million, Sixty-Seven Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$21,067,000.00); and

**WHEREAS**, Bay County, as System Operator, wishes to further negotiate the Additive Alternate Bids as best meets the needs of the project, in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA:**

Section 1. City of Springfield, as joint owner, authorizes Bay County, as System Operator, to tentatively award the base bid contract for the construction of the

Military Point Regional Advanced Wastewater Treatment Facility to Danis Heavy Construction, 100 Chase Park South, Suite 200, Birmingham, Alabama 35244, for a total amount of \$21,067,000.00 subject to Bay County securing approval by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, and authorizes subsequent execution of the contract documents by the Mayor of the City Commission of the City of Springfield, Florida.

Section 2. The City of Springfield, as a joint owner, authorizes Bay County, as System Operator, to negotiate Additive Alternate Bids 1 and 2 in an amount not to exceed \$300,000.00, subject to Bay County securing approval by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection.

Section 3. The City of Springfield authorizes, by adoption of this resolution, Bay County, as System Operator, to establish a contingency allowance in the amount of five percent (5%) of the Contract amount equaling \$1,053,350.00.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by City Commission of the City of Springfield, Florida.
