RESOLUTION 97-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA, AS A JOINT OWNER, PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION TO BAY COUNTY, AS SYSTEM OPERATOR, TO TENTATIVELY AWARD A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE SUBAQUEOUS PORTION OF THE WASTEWATER TRANSMISSION PIPELINE ACROSS ST. ANDREW BAY, TO PHOENIX CONSTRUCTION, PURSUANT TO THE FLORIDA STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN PROGRAM, SUBJECT TO REGULATORY APPROVAL; PROVIDING FOR SUBSEQUENT EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS BY THE MAYOR; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION TO BAY COUNTY TO ESTABLISH A FIVE PERCENT (5%) CONTINGENCY ALLOWANCE, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City of Springfield, as a joint owner, wishes to utilize funds from the Florida State Revolving Fund Loan Program to construct the Subaqueous Portion of the Wastewater Transmission Pipeline; and

WHEREAS, on October 27, 1997, bids were received for the construction of the Subaqueous Pipeline; and

WHEREAS, Baskerville-Donovan, Inc., the System Engineer for the project has recommended tentative award of the base bid contract to Phoenix Construction in the amount of One Million, Six Hundred One Thousand, Twenty and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,601,020.00); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA:

Section 1. City of Springfield, as a joint owner, authorizes Bay County, as System Operator, to tentatively award the base bid contract for the construction of the Subaqueous Portion of the Wastewater Transmission Pipeline Across St. Andrew Bay

to Phoenix Construction for a total amount of \$1,601,020.00 subject to Bay County securing approval by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, and authorizes subsequent execution of the contract documents by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Bay County, Florida.

Section 2. The City of Springfield authorizes, by adoption of this resolution, Bay County, as System Operator, to establish a contingency allowance in the amount of five percent (5%) of the Contract amount equaling \$80,051.00.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by City Commission of the City of Springfield, Florida.
