RESOLUTION 97-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA, AS A JOINT OWNER, PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION TO BAY COUNTY, AS SYSTEM OPERATOR, TO TENTATIVELY AWARD A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE UPLANDS PORTION OF THE WASTEWATER TRANSMISSION PIPELINE AND THE WASTEWATER EFFLUENT REUSE PIPELINE, TO L.S.L.T. CHURCHWELL, PURSUANT TO THE FLORIDA STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN PROGRAM, SUBJECT TO REGULATORY APPROVAL; PROVIDING FOR SUBSEQUENT EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS BY THE MAYOR; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION TO BAY COUNTY TO ESTABLISH A FIVE PERCENT (5%) CONTINGENCY ALLOWANCE, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City of Springfield, as a joint owner, wishes to utilize funds from the Florida State Revolving Fund Loan Program to construct the Uplands Portion of the Wastewater Transmission Pipeline and the Wastewater Effluent Reuse Pipeline; and

WHEREAS, on October 27, 1997, bids were received for the construction of the Uplands Transmission Pipeline and Effluent Reuse Pipeline; and

WHEREAS, Baskerville-Donovan, Inc., the System engineer for the project has recommended tentative award of the base bid contract to L.S.L.T. Churchwell in the amount of One Million, Eight Hundred Forty-Three Thousand, Three Hundred Fifty and 07/100 Dollars (\$1,843,350.07); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. City of Springfield, as a joint owner, authorizes Bay County, as System Operator, to tentatively award the base bid contract for the construction of the Uplands Portion of the Wastewater Transmission Pipeline and the Wastewater Effluent Reuse Pipeline to L.S.L.T. Churchwell for a total amount of \$1,843,350.07, subject to Bay County, as System Operator, securing approval by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, and authorizes subsequent execution of the contract

documents by the Mayor of the City of Springfield, Florida.

Section 2. Bay County, as Systems Operator, intends to negotiate with the City of Panama City for the purchase of their interest in the jointly owned, existing wastewater transmission pipeline along U.S. Highway 98, some 2,575 feet, in an amount not to exceed \$165,000.

Section 3. Said City authorizes, by adoption of this resolution, Bay County to establish a contingency allowance in the amount of five percent (5%) of the Contract amount equaling \$92,167.50.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Commission of the City of Springfield, Bay County, Florida.
