A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF
SPRINGFIELD, BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO ADOPT AN
ANTI-DISPLACEMENT AND RELOCATION POLICY.

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield, Florida, is undertaking a Community Development Program under the provisions of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-383) and amendments thereto; and


WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 requires compliance with the relocation requirements of the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970, hereinafter referred to as the Uniform Act, and implementing regulations issued by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (CFR Title 24, Part 42) when the acquisition of real property occurs; and,

WHEREAS, the City wishes to provide a local policy covering all probable types of relocation which may be necessary in accomplishing CDBG related activities.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the City of Springfield, Florida, hereby adopts the attached Anti-Displacement and Relocation Policy.
