A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA, FINDING THE CITY'S APPLICATION FOR FY1998 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS CONSISTENT WITH THE LOCAL COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; ADOPTING THE LOCAL COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AS THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PLAN AND AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF THE GRANT APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, the City Commission has directed the preparation of an application for Florida Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in the Neighborhood Revitalization category, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has reviewed the application and found it to be consistent with the locally adopted Comprehensive Plan, and

WHEREAS, the locally adopted Comprehensive Plan contains the required elements of a community development plan as defined by the Florida CDBG rules, and

WHEREAS, the grant application process has included citizen participation and commission direction, resulting in a proposed project which meets the City of Springfield's needs for CDBG fundable improvements,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Commission of the City of Springfield, Florida, that


1. The Mayor is authorized and directed to execute all documents pertaining to submission of the grant applications and additional materials as may be requested by the Florida Department of Community Affairs, and to ensure that the applications

are submitted to the Florida Department of Community Affairs in a timely manner.


2. The locally adopted Comprehensive Plan is hereby adopted as the local community development plan for CDBG purposes.
