A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD,
FLORIDA, AMENDING ITS UTILITY DISCONNECT
POLICY.

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to send a second notice on all delinquent utility bills; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission recognizes the need to minimize the fiscal impact of the reoccurring delinquent accounts; and it is

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The City Commission of the City of Springfield, Bay County, Florida, does hereby amend its utility disconnect policy authorizing a second notice to be mailed to all customers that have a remaining balance, after the 16th of the month. All bills not paid by 5:00 p.m. on the 23rd of the month will be charged an additional \$15.00. Cut off will begin on the 24th of the month. Requests for reconnect received after 4:00 p.m. will be turned on the following day between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
