RESOLUTION NO.: 99-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING AMENDED CONNECTION AND IMPACT FEE AMOUNTS FOR RESIDENTIAL, NON-COMMERCIAL AND NON-RENTAL CONNECTIONS IN THE DESCRIBED NORTH SPRINGFIELD AREA DURING THE INITIAL PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS FOLLOWING THE START DATE WHICH SHALL BE ESTABLISHED BY THE CITY COMMISSION.

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of Springfield has substantially completed the North Springfield Sewer Expansion Project;

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission desires to honor certain commitments made to its citizens years ago;

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent of the City Commission that this resolution apply only to residential single family housing units, thereby excluding rentals, commercial properties and businesses; and only one discount per resident.

**NOW BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

1. Described Area: The only area to which this resolution applies is the area included in the North Springfield Sewer Expansion Project.
2. Initial Period: The initial period shall be the six months immediately following the start date to be established by the City Commission.
3. Connection Fees: There will be no sewer connection fees charged to affected persons connecting to the City of Springfield's sewer system, in the described area, during the initial period. After the initial period, affected persons connecting to the

sewer system shall pay in full, the then current connection fee prior to connection.

4. Impact Fees: The amount charged for sewer impact fees of affected persons in the described area shall be reduced to Four Hundred and forty-five dollars (\$445.00) during the initial period. After the initial period, persons connecting to the sewer system shall pay in full the then current impact fees prior to connection.

5. Affected Persons: This resolution shall only be applicable to residents that have established residency and does not apply to rental properties nor commercial properties or businesses. There shall be only one discount per resident.
