

RESOLUTION 00-03

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Charter and Ordinances of the City of Springfield as the same pertain to elections and applicable Florida Statutes, a City Regular Election was scheduled to be held on Tuesday, April 18, 2000, for the purpose of filling two City Commission seats for two year terms; and

WHEREAS, incumbent City Commissioner Carl Curti qualified for re-election and was the only candidate to qualify for Commission Ward Number 1; and


WHEREAS, incumbent City Commissioner Earnest Jordan qualified for re-election and was the only candidate to qualify for commission Ward Number 2; and

WHEREAS, applicable State Law provides that "... when there is only one candidate of any political party qualified for an office, the name of the candidate shall not be printed on the primary election ballot, and such candidate shall be declared nominated for the office.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Springfield that Carl Curti and Earnest Jordan, being unopposed for Commission Ward 1 and 2 respectively, is hereby declared elected as City Commission of the City of Springfield for a two year term commencing with the administering of the Oath of Office and acceptance thereof by the candidate.

PROPOSED, PRESENTED AND PASSED this 1<sup>st</sup> day of May, 2000, NUNC PRO TUNC to April 25, 2000.


