AGREEMENT RESOLUTION**


WHEREAS, as part of the continual updating of the State of Florida Highway System, the Department for the purpose of safety, protection of the investment and other reasons, has constructed and does maintain two and four lane highway facilities within the corporate limits of the City of Springfield, and

WHEREAS, the City is of the opinion that said highway facilities that contain roadside areas and median strip shall be attractively maintained by mowing and litter removal and the City is desirous of maintaining aforementioned highway facilities enters into this agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Commission of the City of Springfield, Bay County, Florida, that


