RESOLUTION NO.: 05-11

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD,
FLORIDA ESTABLISHING SEWER SERVICE RATES AND
ADJUSTING BASE RATES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
2005-06 AND THEREAFTER; REPEALING ALL
RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS THEREOF WHICH ARE IN
CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SPRINGFIELD CITY COMMISSION THAT:

SECTION 1. SEWER RATES.

A. The monthly base charge called for in Section 82-241 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Springfield shall be \$23.00. This base charge shall be independent of the volume of water consumed and shall be in addition to any consumption charge based on the metered volume of water consumed.

B. The consumption charge called for therein of \$6.25 shall be applied to each one thousand gallon units or any portion thereof for the metered volume of water consumed over 2000 gallons.

C. The monthly bill for wastewater service called for in Section 82-241 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Springfield shall be sum of the base charge and the consumption charge applied to all metered water.

D. If City sewer is available and the property owner fails or refuses to connect and use the City's sewer system, then in addition to all remedies provided by law, such owner shall pay the base monthly rate charge for sewer only customers in the amount of \$40.04 for each potential connection that the person is required to, but has not utilized.


SECTION 2. AUTHORIZATION AND REPEALER. This Resolution is adopted pursuant to Sections 82-37, 82-67, 82-241 and 82-247 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Springfield authorizing the amendment of charges and fees by resolution by the City Commission. Those portions of Sections 82-37, 82-67, 82-241 and 82-247 contained in this Resolution which do not specify charges and fees are neither modified nor readopted by this Resolution and are included herein for convenient reference only. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3. CODIFICATION. The appropriate officers and agents of the City are authorized and directed to codify, include and publish the provisions of this Resolution with the City of Springfield Code. Section numbers may be assigned and changed whenever necessary or convenient.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.


