NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Springfield that Carl Curti being unopposed for Commission Seat Ward 1 and Ralph Hammond being unopposed for Commission Seat Ward 2, are each hereby declared elected as a City Commissioner of the City of Springfield for a two year term commencing with the administering of the Oath of Office and acceptance thereof by the candidate.
