## **RESOLUTION NO: 06-09**

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR APPROVAL OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD'S COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Springfield is experiencing a need for physical improvements to benefit low-to-moderate income persons;

**NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Commission of the City of Springfield, Florida, in regular session this  $5^{th}$  day of July, 2006, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program is declared to be a workable program for providing needed physical improvements to benefit low-to-moderate income persons indicated in the proposed 2006 CDBG application.

SECTION 2. The City Commission hereby directs the Chief Elected Official (Mayor) or City Clerk, in his absence, to sign all necessary certifications of the Community Development Block Grant application.

SECTION 3. That the City Commission directs the Chief Elected Official or City Clerk, in his absence, to execute and submit the attached application to the Florida Department of Community Affairs for state approval.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> That the Chief Elected Official or City Clerk, in his absence, is authorized and directed to submit additional information in a timely manner as may be required by the Florida Department of Community Affairs.

SECTION 5. The proposed CDBG application is consistent with the local comprehensive plan.

<u>SECTION 6.</u> The City's comprehensive plan has been adopted as the City's Community Development Plan.

<u>SECTION 7.</u> That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
