**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA,
IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA DECLARING THAT THE
COMPENSATION RECEIVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
COMMISSIONERS FOR THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD AS A
RESULT OF THEIR OFFICIAL POSITIONS SHALL BE
CLASSIFIED AS A SALARY.**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commissioners for the City of Springfield are elected to serve the citizens of the community; and

WHEREAS, in the performance of their official positions, the Mayor and City Commissioners are required to attend monthly, special and workshop meetings, along with other obligations that may arise from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the standard employee deductions such as FICA, Social Security and Federal Withholding Taxes are taken from compensation received by the Mayor and City Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commissioners receive a standard employee tax reporting form known as a W-2 form; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11, of the City of Springfield Charter, the Mayor and City Commissioners are entitled to receive compensation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Any compensation received by the Mayor and City Commissioners from the City of Springfield as a result of their official positions shall be classified as a salary.
