A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA, IN BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA PROVIDING FOR PROCEDURES FOR RECOGNITION OF LONG TERM EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Springfield acknowledge that from time to time employees who have served the citizens of the City of Springfield may leave employment prior to retirement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of Springfield wish to recognize employees who have faithfully served the City of Springfield for 6 years or more; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of Springfield is desirous of providing for procedures for recognition of long term employees for the purpose of acknowledging and showing support and appreciation for long term service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** The City Commission does hereby instruct the City Clerk of the City of Springfield to immediately notify each member of the Commission of a departing employee and of the date of separation of the departing employee.

**SECTION 2.** The City Commission does hereby instruct the City Clerk of the City of Springfield to cause a Certificate of Appreciation for any employee with six (6) years of service or more to be prepared for presentation to the departing employee at the next scheduled City Commission Meeting.

**SECTION 3.** The City Commission does hereby authorize the City Clerk of the City of Springfield to have a Plaque of Appreciation prepared for any employee with twenty (20) or more years of dedicated service to the City of Springfield for presentation to the departing employee at the next scheduled City Commission Meeting.
